We invite submissions of abstracts for a workshop that will deal with the globalisation of Muslim Qur'an translation in the first decades of the 20th century, until the 1960s, against the backdrop of migration and increasing *da'wa* activities.

We welcome contributions on any topic that sheds light on this larger question, for example on

- Qur'an translation in South Asia in the 19th/20th centuries
- the globalisation of *da'wa* at the beginning of the 20th century
- the role of Qur'an translations in Muslim *da'wa* activities
- the emergence of Qur'an translations as a new genre of religious literature in different regions across the globe
- the publishing activities of the two Ahmadiyya movements, particularly in the field of Qur'an translation
- individual Muslim Qur'an translators and translations from the first decades of the 20th century in a historical perspective
- transregional networks, the movement of texts and translations of translations.

Please submit your abstracts (approx. 1000 words) by November 30, 2021 to Professor Dr. Johanna Pink (johanna.pink@orient.uni-freiburg.de) and Kamran Ahmad Khan (kamran.ahmad.khan@orient.uni-freiburg.de). The abstracts should be submitted in English as a PDF file.
